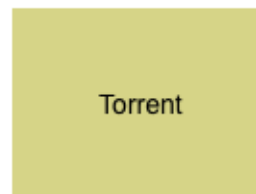
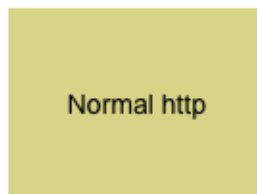

You're done ? let's burn a Temp Tails Stick

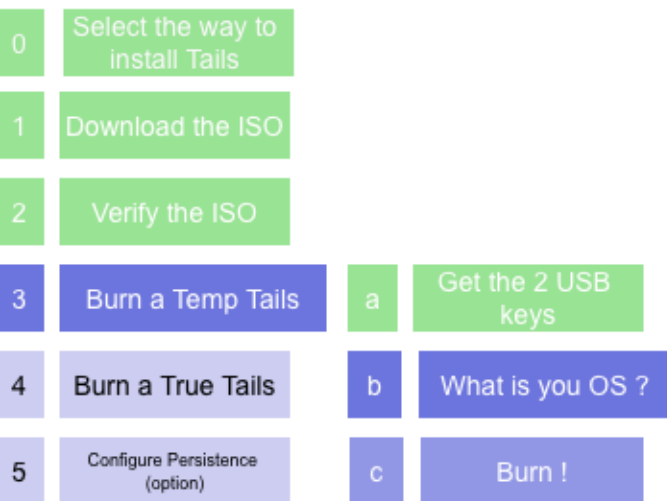

Time to get the 2 USB key you need.  
They must be at least 4go.

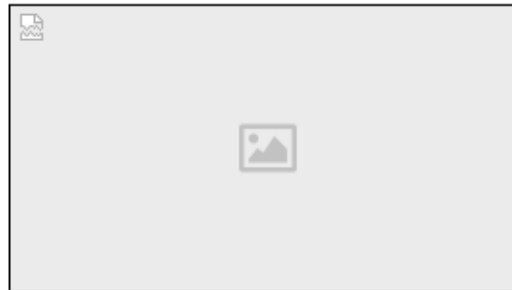

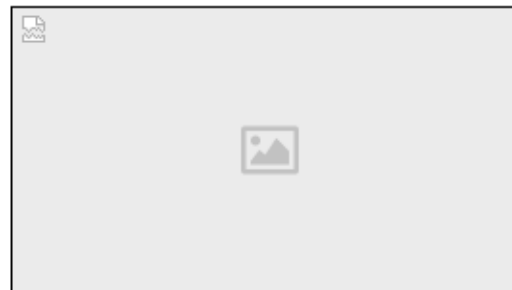

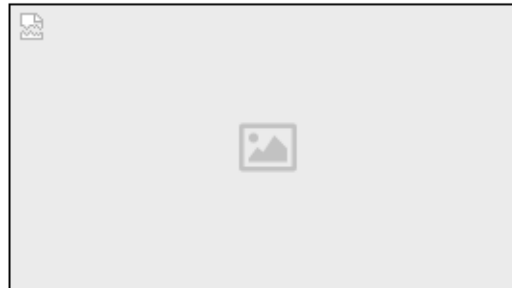
