Tails is not working on every mac and we don't have (yet) a list of supported models. You will have to try **different ways** to install it.

At the end, maybe :

- it will **not** be **possible** to boot with Tails with you mac :-)
- you will **boot on a full-feature Tails** :-)
- you will only **boot on a minimal Tails** (no automatic upgrades and persistence)
- you will have a booting Tails, with **some hardware issue** (wifi, screen)

TRY TO CLONE FROM A FRIEND

If you know someone of trust who uses Tails already, it may work installing your USB stick by copying from it (if it fails, come back here)

If you don't know someone who use Tails or if you tried to clone and it failed booting, *then* you should try this **2 ways** (if one fail, come back and try the other one) :

TRY COMMANDE LINE

It can be a bit difficult.

TRY WITH A DVD

If you have a DVD burner.
